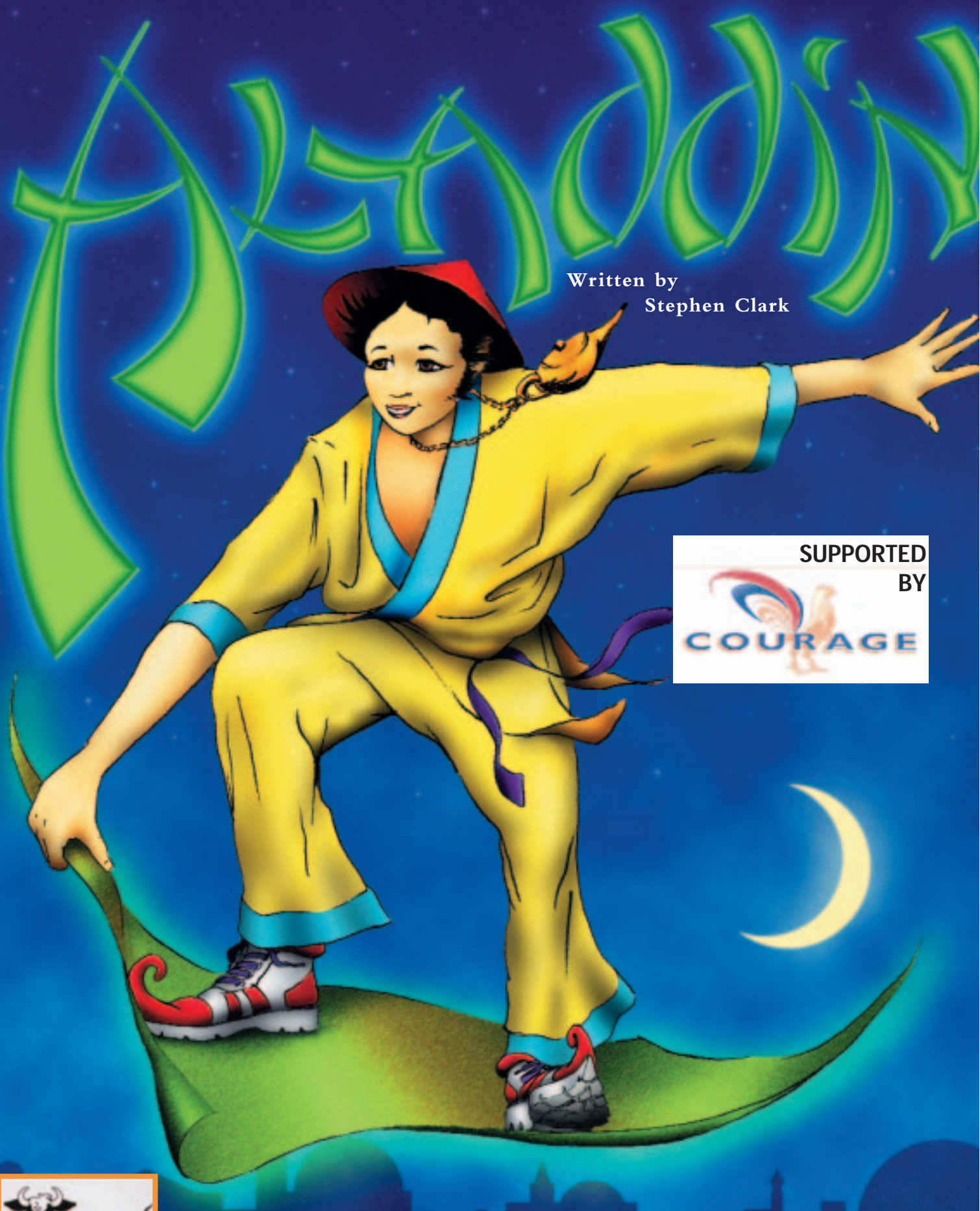

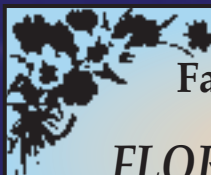

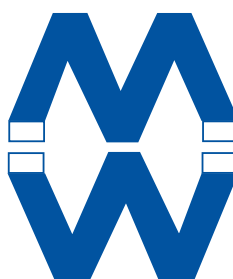

We've managed to retain most of our regular cast but as ever there has been a turnover of some of our younger members who seem to grow up so quickly and turn their attentions to other things.

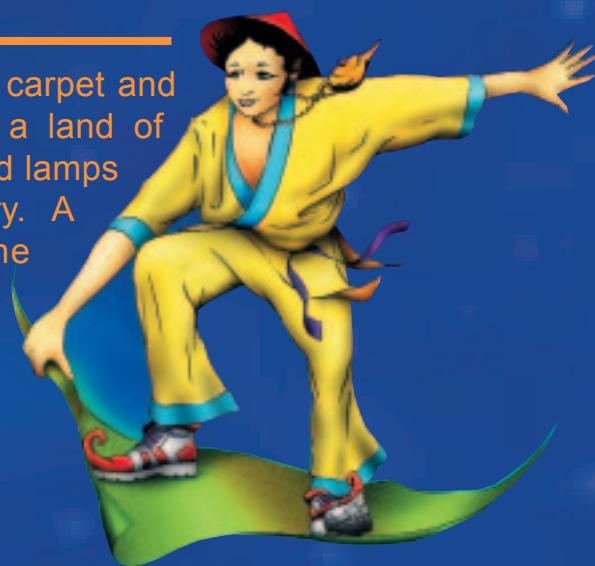
The proceeds of our Pantomime as always go to charitable organisations in the area so may I thank you for supporting us and therefore giving support to these organisations.

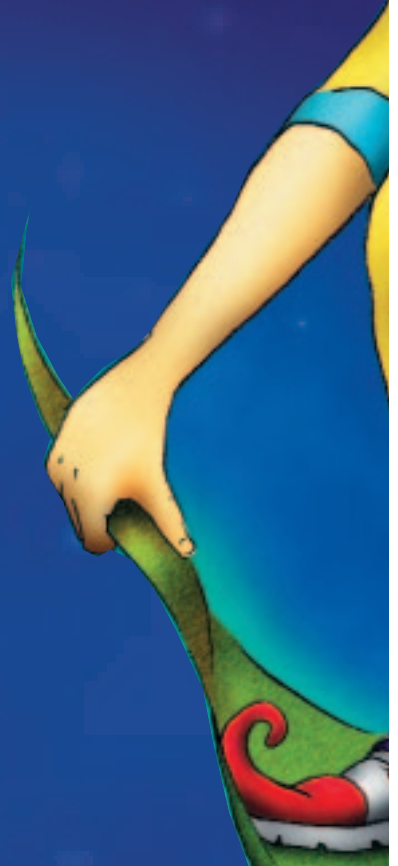
